Funding system 2022

- * Funding is based on 1) ranking for one best result from 2021 and 2) solidarity support by applications
- * Federation Support altogether 48 000 € for year 2021 (all results go to federation support):
 - * Funding based on ranking 30 000€
 - * Solidarity support by application 18 000 €
 - * National Pajulahti-foundation support 5000 €
- * NOC support 50 000 € for athletes listed in NOC presentation 40 000 + (10 000 – May 2022)
- * Top team will have double points because they're committed for top team training system.
- * If no results and funding is less than 2000€, SR, U23, JR(2022) can apply for solidarity support 2022 (athlete must present year plan and budget)
- * Coaching committee decide about solidarity support based on applications with help of head coach
- * Use of any support only through federation invoices/bills for judo events
- * If someone is injured, he get 50% of amount from last year (money go direct from basic Federation funding)
- * In future only named tournaments are counted for ranking. Now we see/watch situation how covid effects.
- * Highest individual support can be 20 000 € in year 2022.
- * Depending on athlete's support, only part of it can be used for one event. Eg. If event costs 1000 €, 30% has to be paid by self.
- * If support is less than 5000 €, 40 % can be paid from support and 60 % yourself
- * If support is less than 2000 €, 25 % can be paid by support and rest 70% yourself
